Our Approach



At Kingfishers Preschool, our aim is to provide a safe, secure and caring environment in which your child can learn through play and develop their confidence and independence.

We continually review our practice and provision, recently investing in new equipment for our inside and large outside area. We have been developing the curriculum to include new exciting topics and activities. The children also have the opportunity to attend 'Forest School' sessions during their time with us.

The EYFS sets standards for the learning, development and care of children from birth to 5 years old. This gives all professionals a set of common principles and commitments to deliver a quality early education and child care experiences for all children.

The purpose built Kingfishers building is arranged into different areas of learning including

- a creative table
- role play
- writing table
- construction area
- computer area
- sand and water area.

The children can choose which area they would like to work in and have the flexibility to move between areas whenever they choose. There is also the offer of adult led activities focussing on different areas of learning throughout the week.

Everything is based around a topic; we have covered

- People Who Help Us
- Healthy Eating
- Space.

The topics are changed half termly or termly to keep the children motivated. We also enhance their learning with visitors and trips included a visit from a policeman and a trip to the local post office.

Staff spend all of their time interacting with the children during the sessions. They talk to the children about their learning and help them move forward with their activities. During this time the staff are also continuously assessing each child to inform their future planning and individual needs.

We are keen to share your child's learning journey with you. We have parent meetings twice a year and you will receive a report as your child moves onto school.

We are always accessible and welcome the chance to talk informally with you.
