Bible story	The Feeding of the Five Thousand John 6:1-14
Possible objects to include for storytelling	Small soft lion toy or plastic jungle animals, picnic rug and small basket with pictures of loaves and fish
Pictures	You can use Google images or any pictures you may choose to discuss with children how compassion is expressed in different situations e.g. helping others in practical ways, offering comfort when it is needed
Prayer	Dear God, Thank you that you care for each one of us, whoever we are and whatever we do. You know what we need and are always there to help us.. We ask, Lord, that we may learn to follow your example, showing kindness and care towards everyone, not just those who are our friends. Amen
