Bible and Story links to our School Christian Values

- The idea behind these story and bible links is to give children (EYFS, KS1 and Lower KS2) an insight into each of our different School Christian values and also to be able to relate this to their own ideas and experiences both in school and at home.
- There is a link made between a secular story and a Biblical one. If parents prefer they may substitute other stories they consider relevant to the value, but making sure that they retain a Biblical story which demonstrates the value from a Christian perspective. The theological basis, or Christian teaching about each value is included with each template. More detailed reference can be accessed from www.christianvalues4schools.co.uk
- Although the attached template for each value gives suggested book titles and Bible stories, another source of reference is *Values for Life* from the Diocese of Gloucester, Jumping Fish publications.
- The objects used within each story should reflect the different elements of the stories so that children can re-tell or re-enact the stories themselves. Teachers and/or children may wish to add to the given suggestions.
- Pictures give an added visual stimulus which reflect the ideas incorporated within the value being explored. These can be sourced through Google or any appropriate photos.
- The prayer and appropriate Bible verse included in the table reinforce learning about our given Christian Value.

- These Christian Value story links may be used as part of an RE lesson or in collective worship, particularly if led by the children themselves. They can also be used at home with their families to allow the children to deepen their understanding of the school Christian values.
- The ideas given in the templates are starting points to engage children, to deepen their understanding of our Christian values and to allow them to respond to the given stimulus. For teachers and parents these are a ready-made resource which can be used in whatever way is appropriate to the age of the children they are looking at each School Christian Value in more depth.

Secular Story	Lucy's Quarrel by Jennifer Northway pub. Frances Lincoln Children's Books
Bible story	The Story of the Lost Son Luke 15: 11-24
Possible objects to include for storytelling	2 dolls to represent the 2 girls party balloons, bag of coins, a ring
Pictures	You can use Google images or any pictures you may choose to discuss with children how forgiveness is expressed e.g. father hugging his children, children saying sorry to each other, and God's forgiveness expressed on the Cross
Prayer	<p style="text-align: center;">Dear God,</p> <p style="text-align: center;">We thank you that you are a loving heavenly father, who, when we have done or said wrong things, are always ready to forgive us when we ask you and we are ready to put wrong things right. We ask you to help us as well to forgive others when they do wrong to us. Amen</p>
Bible verse	Forgive us our sins, as we forgive everyone who sins against us. Luke 11:14

Secular Story	<i>The Lion who wanted to love</i> by Giles Andreae pub. Orchard Picturebooks
Bible story	The Feeding of the Five Thousand John 6:1-14
Possible objects to include for storytelling	Small soft lion toy or plastic jungle animals, picnic rug and small basket with pictures of loaves and fish
Pictures	You can use Google images or any pictures you may choose to discuss with children how compassion is expressed in different situations e.g. helping others in practical ways, offering comfort when it is needed
Prayer	<p style="text-align: center;">Dear God,</p> <p>Thank you that you care for each one of us, whoever we are and whatever we do. You know what we need and are always there to help us.. We ask, Lord, that we may learn to follow your example, showing kindness and care towards everyone, not just those who are our friends. Amen</p>
Bible verse	<p>The Lord is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and rich in love. The Lord is good to all: he has compassion on all he has made.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Psalm 145:8-9</p>

Secular Story	The Hare and the Tortoise retold by Brian Wildsmith, pub. OUP
Bible story	Jesus heals the paralysed man Mark 2: 1-12
Possible objects to include for storytelling	Toys to represent the hare and the tortoise, lego or duplo bricks to make a house with a flat roof, small lego or other plastic figures
Pictures	You can use Google images or any pictures you may choose to discuss with children how endurance or perseverance is an important aspect of life for everyone, old or young and the different situations we need to be able to do this
Prayer	<p>Heavenly Father,</p> <p>We thank you that you teach us not to give up but to keep going even when we find things difficult. Thank you that you never give up on anyone and are always here for us. We ask that you will help us day by day so that we may learn to do our very best in every way.</p> <p>Amen</p>
Bible verse	For everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that through the endurance taught in the Scriptures and the encouragement they provide, we might have hope.

Bible story	The Man Who Came Through The Roof Luke 5: 17-26
Possible objects to include for storytelling	Teddy bear, Play people
Pictures	Kittens with paw around , Friendship jigsaw pieces, Be a friend to thyself picture
Prayer	Lord Jesus, thank you for my friends, and the games and the fun that we share. Please help me to be a good friend to them. Amen.
Bible verse	Proverbs 17:17 A friend loves at all times Ecclesiastes 4:10 If one falls down, a friend can lift him up

Secular Story	<i>Lost and Found</i> by Oliver Jeffers pub. Harper Collins
Bible story	The Lost Sheep Luke 15:3-7
Possible objects to include for storytelling	Penguin, boat, duck, signpost for the South Pole, Sheep, with a shepherd's crook
Pictures	You can use Google images or any pictures you may choose to discuss with children how they express hope e.g. snowdrops appearing at the end of winter - sign of spring on the way!
Prayer	Dear God, Thank you that you always look after us, and care for us whatever situation we are in. Even when we have done wrong you still love us. You give us hope because you love us. Amen
Bible verse	And so Lord, where do I put my hope? My only hope is in you. Psalm 39:7

It is rooted in the love and faithfulness of God, a firm assurance that He can be relied upon. His promises can be trusted. A number of Biblical references are given to affirm this

Bible story	Jesus heals the 10 lepers Luke 17:11-19
Possible objects to include for storytelling	Rabbit, donkey, sheep figures, , tree, plant figures, green felt for grass, fruit, vegetables
Pictures	You can use Google images or any pictures you may choose to discuss with children how thankfulness is expressed in daily life e.g. for food, the created world, when we share what we've got with others, situations when God helps us

Possible objects to include for storytelling	Small toy boat, blue material for the sea Two small teddy bears and a torch, picture of the moon. Toy lion, play people
Pictures	Pictures showing examples of: An adult catching a child as he jumps, It takes years to build trust quote, One man guiding another man who is wearing a blindfold.
Prayer	Dear God, We know that sometimes it can be hard to do the right thing. Please help us to trust in you and show us which way to go. Amen
Bible verse	Psalm 56:3 When I am afraid, I will trust in you. Romans 15:13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so

	that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Prayer	Keep us O Lord from pettiness let us be kind in thought in word and in our actions. Help us to be always kind to others. Amen

Bible verse	The Lord gives strength to his people , the Lord blesses his people with peace. Psalm 29-11

Prayer	Lord, Thank you for sending Jesus to die on the cross so that we can have our sins forgiven. Thank you for forgiving my sins. Please help me to forgive others as You forgive us. Amen.
