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In Key Stage 1 the children bring home their learning log every week and will either be asked to do an English, Maths or Topic based activity. The task will either build upon an activity done that week in class or be something that they are going to be doing the following week to begin to develop knowledge and understanding of this. The learning log activity can take as long as you feel is appropriate for your child, depending on what it is and what you feel is a suitable length of time to spend on it.

The children bring home spellings to be learnt every week. These are based upon the phonics they are learning within class and key sight words that they still cannot spell.

We also encourage children to begin to learn the 2, 5 and 10 times tables at home when they are ready.

Reading regularly at home is important. This can be done not only by sharing your child's school reading book but sharing recipes, lists, poems, comics, non-fiction texts and children's newspapers.
